Said that Secretary Mathews would like to talk to the President regarding the \$90 million recission that has been proposed on education for the handicapped.

The Secretary feels that the time is not appropriate, that Congress will not go along with it, that even though Congress does not go along with it the money will still be available after school starts and it will be a waste when they can be using the money now, and that it will not be beneficial to the President politically.

The Secretary would like to talk to the President about this today or tomorrow. Mr. Lias feels sure that it could be done by phone.... or if the President would like for the Secretary to come in, the Secretary would be happy to do that also.

The big problem is timing....the Secretary would like to talk to the President today or tomorrow.
