SUBJECT: MINNESOTA UP-DATE

Enclosed are the results of our canvass of the Minnesota State Convention reported by our District Leaders and Field Leaders at last night's meeting in Minnesota.

We have submitted a slate of 18 Ford people, 16 committed and 2 uncommitted. The 2 uncommitted are the State Chairman and National Committeewoman, who are solidly for you, but because of their Party roll, we will run them uncommitted.

Reagan people today offered a 12-6 split. We turned them down.

Bill Russo is in Minnesota now, and I will arrive there Thursday afternoon for the Rules Committee meeting.
