Attached for your consideration is H.R. 10792, sponsored by Representative Metcalfe, which would expedite the citizenship eligibility date for Jana Hlavaty in order to make her eligible to compete in the 1976 Olympics on the U.S. ski team. Under the U.S. immigration laws, Mrs. Hlavaty would be eligible to become a U.S. citizen on March 15, 1976, however, unless she is naturalized by January 20, 1976 she will be unable to compete in the 1976 Olympics.

Additional information is provided in OMB's enrolled bill report at Tab A.

OMB, Max Friedersdorf, Counsel's Office (Lazarus), NSC and I recommend approval of the enrolled bill.

Jana Hlavaty was born in Czechoslovakia on August 29, 1941. She and her husband, Vaclav Hlavaty, came to the United States as visitors for pleasure on August 26, 1969, and were granted permanent resident status on March 15, 1971. Under the U.S. immigration laws, both she and her husband would be eligible to become U.S. citizens on March 15, 1976.

Mrs. Hlavaty is one of the top women members of the U.S. Olympic Ski Team and had intended to compete on behalf of the U.S. in the World Olympics to be held in Austria in January 1976. According to World Olympic rules, however, only citizens

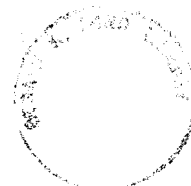


of a country may compete on behalf of that country. Thus, unless Mrs. Hlavaty is naturalized by January 20, 1976, she will be ineligible to compete. Her current eligibility date would miss this deadline by less than two months.

H.R. 10792 would declare Mrs. Hlavaty to have been granted permanent resident status as of August 26, 1969, the day she originally entered the country as a visitor, thus making her immediately eligible for citizenship. The enrolled bill would not apply to her husband and would not relieve her of any of the other requirements for citizenship. The Immigration and Naturalization Service has no information, however, which would make her ineligible for citizenship on any other grounds.

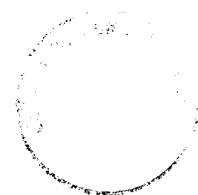

Our office received a call from Cong. Jack Kemp's office the first thing this morning, asking us to ask the President to sign the above bill as soon as possible.

This is a private bill for Jana Hlavaty. She is a candidate for the American Olympics ski team and she must be a naturalized citizen before she can compete. The team is leaving January 7th for Europe and she would like to accompany them at that time. The immigration people have to be notified at the soonest possible moment.

This is in reply to Mr. Frey's request for the Department's views on enrolled bill H. R. 10792, for the relief of Jana Hlavaty.

Both the U.S. Olympic Committee and the U.S. Ski Association are extremely interested in this bill and have reported to the Department that the beneficiary, Jana Hlavaty, could make an outstanding contribution to the U.S. Ski Team's showing at the Winter Olympics in Innsbruck, Austria during the month of February 1976.

Mrs. Hlavaty was a member of the U.S. Ski Team at the World Ski Championships in Falun, Sweden in February 1974 and is a top candidate for the 1976 U.S. Olympics Winter Team. However, we are informed that in order to compete in the Olympics as a U.S. Team member, she must be a U. S. citizen.

The Department of State has no objection to the approval of H. R. 10792.
