SUBJECT: H.R. 14470 - Relief of Raul Eduardo Ringle

Attached for your consideration is H.R. 14470, sponsored by Representative Baucus.

The enrolled bill would facilitate issuance of an immigrant visa to the adopted child of U.S. citizens. The beneficiary is a 20-year old citizen of Bolivia. He has been ineligible under immigration law to obtain an adopted child immigrant visa because he was over the age of fourteen at the time of his adoption.

Additional information is provided in OMB's enrolled bill report at Tab A.

OMB, Max Friedersdorf, Counsel's Office (Kilberg), NSC and I recommend approval of the enrolled bill.

Purpose

To facilitate issuance of an immigrant visa to the adopted alien child of U.S. citizens.

Discussion

The beneficiary is a 20-year-old citizen of Bolivia who was adopted in Bolivia by U.S. citizen missionaries. Since the age of four he had been in the custody of Salvation Army mission centers in Bolivia and Chile. He was adopted in Bolivia at age eighteen by Mr. and Mrs. Edward Ringle on July 18, 1974.

In December 1975, Mr. and Mrs. Ringle were transferred back to the United States by the Salvation Army. However, Raul could not accompany them; he was ineligible under immigration law to obtain an adopted child immigrant visa because he was over fourteen years old at the time of his adoption. H.R. 14470

would classify Raul as a child for purposes of immigration law and authorize the issuance of an immigrant visa to him upon approval by the Immigration and Naturalization Service of the orphan visa petition filed in his behalf by Mr. and Mrs. Ringle. The enrolled bill would also declare that his natural parents and siblings are not to be accorded preferential immigration treatment as his relatives.

An Act

For the relief of Raúl Eduardo Ringle.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, in the administration of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Raúl Eduardo Ringle may be classified as a child within the meaning of section 101(b)(1)(F) of the Act, upon approval of a petition filed in his behalf by Mr. and Mrs. Edward Ringle, citizens of the United States, pursuant to section 204 of the Act: *Provided*, That the natural parents or brothers or sisters of the beneficiary shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.*
