



Dear Mr. President,

I sincerely thank you for the message which you were very kind in sending me as you assumed office as President of the United States of America.

I fully share your views on the strength of the democratic system. Turkey, too, has proven many times its devotion to the rules of democratic order.

I have noted with great satisfaction that you intend to honour and support the commitments undertaken on foreign policy matters by the former President of the United States of America, Mr. Nixon who, as you have rightly stated, tried his best to create a framework of understanding and cooperation between the United States of America and its allies, based on the principles of mutual respect and interest. It was equally satisfactory to learn from your message that you have asked Dr. Kissinger to continue as Secretary of State.

Mr. President, I must assure you that Turkey fully understands the keen interest of the United States of America in connection with the

Cyprus problem. I am pleased to note that the United States of America is aware of the utmost restraint Turkey has exercised since the very beginning of the question. I think, humiliation which is undesirable for any concerned party, can only be avoided, Mr. President, when the Turkish Cypriots are given enough assurances within a new legitimate and working order in their own region in which they will enjoy the same rights, liberties and priviliges with the Greek Cypriots. We will appreciate the positive role to be played by the United States of America in this connection.

Lastly, Mr. President, I would like to state once again my readiness to offer my support to you when it is needed.

It is my strong belief that the cooperation and understanding between our two allied countries will be ever lasting.





LEADERSHIP IN THE PERTOD SINCE THE SIGNING OF THE PARIS AGREEMENTS, I HAVE BEEN HEARTENED BY HIS REPORT OF YOUR PERSONAL DETERMINATION TO CONTINUE THE IMPROVEMENT OF YOUR GOVERNMENTAL PROCESSES TO INSURE THAT OUR AID, AND THE INCREASING AID WE COMPIDENTLY EXPECT FROM OTHER DONOR COUNTRIES, CAN BE RAPIDLY AND EFFECTIVELY UTILIZED TO BRING THE SOUTH VIETNAMESE ECONOMY TO A SELF-SUSTAINING LEVEL IN THE NEXT FEW YEARS.
