General Information

Material on individuals is filed under the subjects name, rather than the Department or Agency.

Budget - includes Congressional Budget resolution and all material regarding past or future budgets

CIA - filed in the Domestic rather than Foreign guidance

Economy - includes:

- Wholesale Price Index
- Consumer Price Index
- Tax related material
- GNP material
- Ullman Tax Rebate plan

Energy - includes:

- Oil
- Petroleum
- Gas
- Ullman - Energy proposals
- Energy tax material
