EX. COMMITTEE  
OF RNC:

The President began the meeting by thanking the people there for their help in the campaign and mentioned again the fact that he had started very far back and came very close to winning. He indicated his support for the idea for the Rep. Coordinating Committee. He said the Committee was one of the reasons for the good comeback in '66 and '68. Thought it was important to begin to find the good candidates now to run in 1978. As to his own role in the Party, the President said "to the degree I am helpful, I will be in there working with you. We have to have an organization as well as principles so that the RNC has a significant role in 1978. Having dedicated 28 years of my life to the principles I believe in, I don't intend to sit on the sidelines. I am looking forward to an exciting period ahead. Stories indicating that I am depressed or recluse are just not true. The President ended his remarks by saying that the Rep. Party needs to strengthen our part of the 2-party system in every state. Ron said the President has no plans to run for office in the future.

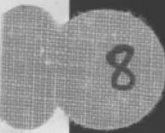
