SUBJECT: Letter from Prime Minister Trudeau

Prime Minister Trudeau has written (Tab A) to express his "warm appreciation" for the vigorous support you gave to Canada's desire to participate in the Rambouillet meetings. He was encouraged by your statement that the U.S. would insist on Canada's being involved in any follow up to Rambouillet, and believes that this has now been accepted by all the governments involved.

Trudeau was also "heartened to learn" of the consensus at Rambouillet on the need for coordinated responses to the major economic problems facing the industrialized nations and assures you that he shares your desire to cooperate in very way possible in the solution of key economic issues.

We have provided the Canadians a detailed readout of the Rambouillet discussions. We have also taken the initiative to include Canada in restricted meetings in other forums dealing with issues discussed at Rambouillet.

No response to Trudeau's letter is required.
