NEW RUG IN PRESIDENT FORD'S OVAL OFFICE

A new rug, specially designed for the Oval Office of the President, was installed in the room on December 22, 1976.

The ground of the rug is a pale gold color with turquoise blue rosettes throughout the field. The Savonnerie style border has classical motifs in colors harmonizing with the upholsteries and draperies in the office. The rug measures 24.2 x 30.11.

The design for the rug was selected by the President and Mrs. Ford in mid 1975 after designs submitted by the architectural consultant to the Committee for the Preservation of the White House, Mr. Edward V. Jones and Edward Fields, Inc., manufacturers of the rug. The rug will be paid for with contributed funds.
