- Federal Energy Administration (FEA). This bill was signed by the President on May 7.
- Mandatory Reporting of Energy Information. Since this bill was transmitted on February 22, 1974, the Bill creating the FEA has been enacted. OMB and FEA have concluded that the FEA Act provides adequate information authority.

ADMINISTRATION ENERGY LEGISLATION
AWAITING CONGRESSIONAL ACTION

• Natural Gas Supply Act

- Allows competitive pricing of newly developed gas supplies, thereby encouraging exploration and development of new wells.
- Bill submitted April 1973. Hearings were held in Senate Commerce Committee -- most recently in March 1974. The Committee is making up a bill. The direction of the Committee's thinking is not known with certainty. It appears headed toward continued and perhaps expanded price regulation -- based primarily on cost rather than market factors. No action in the House.

• Mined Area Protection Act

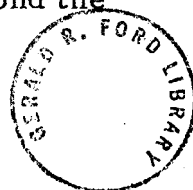
- Establishes standards to govern surface effects of coal mining; would allow mining to proceed with reasonable environmental protection and reclamation requirements.
- Bill submitted in February 1971 and resubmitted February, 1973. Senate passed (October, 1973) surface coal mining bill has unacceptable provisions. House Interior Committee reported a bill too which is also unacceptable. House floor action expected in June 1974.

• Naval Petroleum Reserves

- Allow one-year production from Elk Hills Naval Petroleum Reserves and provide funds for exploration of reserves.
- Resolution submitted November 6, 1973. Senate action complete. Congressman Hebert and House Armed Services refusing to act on the Resolution.

• Deepwater Ports Facilities Act

- Authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to grant permits for the construction, licensing and operation of ports beyond the three-mile limit.



- Bill submitted April 18, 1973. Three Senate Committees held joint hearings but little motion is evident. Two House Committees have reported competing bills to Rules Committee. (Merchant Marine and Fisheries Committee bill is generally acceptable: Public Work's is generally unacceptable. Rule gives greatest chance of favorable action to Public Works bill. Floor action is expected during the week of June 3.

- Appliance and Motor Vehicle Energy Labelling Act

- Requires that major appliances and motor vehicles be labelled to show energy use and efficiency.
- Bill submitted March 3, 1974. No action yet.

- Special Energy Act of 1974

- Provides standby authority for rationing and mandatory conservation measures and grants to States.
- Bill submitted March 10, 1974. No action on this bill but authority may be provided in Senator Jackson's "standby" energy bill that is being debated in the Senate.

- Revision of Nuclear Licensing Process

- Modifies nuclear licensing to encourage standardization of nuclear plant designs and early site review and approval so as to reduce the time required for getting plants on line.
- Bill submitted March 8, 1974. Hearings held by Joint Committee on Atomic Energy on March 19-21. Markup is underway. Outlook is favorable.

- Electric and Energy Facilities Siting

- Electric Facilities Siting
 - .. Electric Facilities Siting bill would have provided procedures for expediting siting and facilities approval at Federal and State levels.
 - .. Bill submitted in February, 1971 and resubmitted in 1973. No action in this Congress; outlook is very poor.



- Energy Facilities Siting

- .. Bill is being developed which would cover all energy facilities but would take a somewhat different approach than the electric facilities siting bill described above.
- .. Bill was promised in the President's January 23, 1974 energy message. FEA will submit a revised bill for OMB clearance during the week of June 3.

. Clean Air Act Amendments

- Extends certain deadlines and temporarily relaxes requirements with respect to transportation control plans, auto emissions and pollution from stationary sources such as power plants; requires an EPA plan to eliminate the expected clean fuels deficit; authorizes indefinite use of intermittent control strategies; provides legislative relief from court "significant deterioration" decisions.
- Thirteen Administration amendments submitted on March 22, 1974. EPA dissents from two amendments. Hearings in House planned for mid-June. No hearings scheduled in Senate.

. Minerals Leasing Act

- Places all mineral exploration and mining activities on Federal lands under a modernized leasing system.
- Bill submitted October 12, 1971; resubmitted February, 1973. Senate Interior held hearings on April 2, 1974. No action in House.

Energy Related Taxes

. Windfall Profits Tax

- Imposes a tax up to 85% on the selling price of domestic crude oil above December 1, 1973 ceilings. Proposal announced December 19, 1973; described in February 4, 1974 testimony.
- Comprehensive petroleum tax bill recently reported by House Ways and Means includes a similar proposal, but with forgiveness for investment.



. Foreign Depletion Allowance

- Eliminate the 22% depletion deduction permitted in computing U. S. taxes on foreign production of oil and gas -- to encourage investment in U. S. rather than foreign energy resources.
- Described in February 4, 1974 testimony. Provided for in bill recently reported by the House Ways and Means Committee.

. Foreign Tax Credits

- Limits foreign tax credits available to U. S. oil and gas companies operating in foreign lands. (Excessive portion of taxes paid to foreign governments would be treated as an expense rather than tax credit in computing U. S. tax.)
- Described in February 4, 1974 testimony. This approach was rejected by the House Ways and Means Committee and a less effective provision is included in the petroleum tax bill recently reported.

. Drilling Investment Tax Credit

- Provides a tax credit similar to investment tax credit for costs of exploratory drilling for new oil and gas fields in the U. S.
- Proposed in April, 1973. No action.

Federal Energy Organization

. Energy R&D Administration and Nuclear Energy Commission

- ERDA would provide a central agency for managing most Federal energy R&D, including functions transferred from Atomic Energy Commission, Interior, National Science Foundation and EPA. NEC would carry out nuclear licensing functions of the AEC.
- Legislation proposed on June 29, 1973. The House passed an acceptable bill in December. The full Senate Government Operations Committee will take up the bill reported by the Reorganization Subcommittee on May 29. Senate floor action should occur in mid-June. Outlook is favorable.



• Department of Energy and Natural Resources

- Provides a new Cabinet Department for energy and natural resources programs including most responsibilities of Interior and selected programs from Agriculture, Commerce, Transportation, Corps of Engineers and Water Resources Council.
- Legislation proposed June 29, 1973. Hearings by House and Senate Government Operations Committees in August, 1973. Followup hearings in Senate Government Operations in March, 1974. Favorable action not likely during the current session.

Related Bill

• Job Security Assistance Proposal

- Strengthens the unemployment insurance program by extending coverage and providing additional benefits.
- Proposed in 1973 and amended in February 1974. Part of this proposal may be incorporated in the energy emergency bill if that bill is revived. No action has been taken on the total Administration package.

This measure, vital to the creation of ERDA, was granted a rule today after a compromise was worked out in the jurisdictional dispute between House Interior Committee and Science and Astronautics Committee. It is a one hour open rule with an Interior Committee substitute made in order.

This should take care of Senator Jackson's concern. The Rules Committee had deferred action on this bill on July 16.

Apparently, this compromise does not keep Science and Astronautics from holding jurisdiction over future legislation in this area. The bill is not yet scheduled for House floor consideration, but will probably be up next week.

- FEA should take on the bulk of the Hill tracking and contact work and briefings of others concerned.

Promotion of National Program

The omnibus bill approach would necessitate a well organized public promotion effort to explain the National program in gaining the necessary Congressional, State/local, public, union and industry support that would be essential to passage and implementation. Such a program needs to be planned now to follow through after the Presidential announcement. It would probably involve:

- extensive briefings to the Congress
- possible conferences with State governors
- meetings with appropriate union and industry officials
- dialogue with the general public

We need to plan and get this aspect underway quickly and it would be best handled at the White House level.

Management of the legislation

The omnibus bill will require management as a package. This means central control of testimony, tracking, negotiation and trade-off decisions. On many issues that will arise over time, the President's right to decide must be preserved.

In terms of responsibilities the following seems appropriate:

- The Energy Resources Council should be the primary control vehicle with Rogers Morton and yourself having executive oversight authority and responsibility. All key issues and decisions would be channeled to the ERC and to the President as deemed appropriate.
- Basic responsibility for Congressional strategy will be White House - Max Friedersdorf.
- The Domestic Council role would be consistent with ERC membership responsibilities.
- OMB responsibility would include both budgetary and legislative review activities. General leadership would fall in my area. Issues would be handled via the ERC.



I believe that there is considerable advantage to packaging all energy initiatives into a single omnibus energy bill. My reasons include:

- Clearly places President in leadership role by laying out national policy that has potential of solving the problem.
- Puts significant pressure and responsibility on Congressional leadership to act on a National Policy rather than letting individual committee chairmen act on bits and pieces.
- Demonstrates to other Nations that the President is serious about taking strong action in the energy area.

There are some significant risks inherent in the omnibus approach including:

- Creation of a major issue in both Houses over committee jurisdiction. (Refer to Attachment 1 for committee jurisdictions affected by the initiatives). Both Houses would probably make joint referrals (House authorized to do so for first time by Hansen Resolution reorganizing House) to several committees. The question is whether a conglomerate bill would force a greater degree of central management by the leadership of each House as opposed to the committee chairmen. If we could induce the leadership to play this stronger role--and in fact they can--it could be to our advantage. This would be a major piece of legislation in the 94th Congress; it could not be ignored.
- The conglomerate approach would be a major test of Presidential legislative strength--can it be held together and can we avoid massive "Christmas treeing"? Once started, we could not afford to turn back and nobody can predict the outcome.

Even though there are risks, they are outweighed by the advantages. I strongly favor the omnibus approach and recommend an energy bill package along the lines described in Attachment 2.

In moving ahead there are several important issues that must be decided quickly to facilitate final preparation of necessary energy legislation as well as mounting a significant effort to gain support and eventual enactment by Congress. I believe the key issues are these:

- timing and sequence of the energy and economic announcements;
- packaging of the energy legislation;
- approach for promoting and managing the energy legislation.

Timing and Sequence

With regard to the energy/economic program Presidential announcements I strongly believe that there are only two practical choices; either handle both jointly or let the energy message follow the economic message. My preference is to have both announced jointly since they are closely related. Hopefully, the economic package will include some good news for consumers, e.g., "tax cut" to counter and offset the "harsh news" in the energy package concerning gasoline and fuel oil prices. A strong public case explaining this interrelationship is absolutely necessary to gain initial acceptance of the energy package by the Congress and the consumer.

Packaging of Energy Legislation

In looking at the range and variety of legislative initiatives for energy a crucial issue is how this legislation will be "packaged" in order to have the greatest chance of getting it enacted by Congress. I am sure you recall the earlier approach of last year when we had in effect 20 plus separate energy related bills on the Hill at the same time, plus being confronted by the omnibus approach of Senator Jackson and Congressman Staggers in the Energy Emergency Act. Based on those enacted (only several of 20) we don't want to repeat this approach.

4. Excise tax on pleasure craft and private autos of high horsepower
5. Restrictions on the sale of gasoline on certain days
6. Temporary relaxation of environmental constraints on use of coal and auto emissions
7. Long term loans for home insulation, and
8. A national examination of the utility rate structure especially low rates for high usage.

The above points are expected to be presented to the Caucus by Representative Morris K. Udall.
