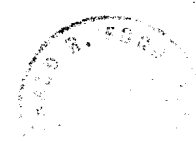

Mr. Rhodes strongly endorses the schedule proposal for June 9, 1975, for a Rose Garden ceremony wherein the President would greet the 30 graduates of the Capitol Page School and their parents and present Presidential certificates to each graduate.

Warren Rustand has had correspondence with Debbie Gelin and Michael Vorhaus, the latter being President of the class of 1975.

I am told that this ceremony has been held annually since the Eisenhower Administration. The President served with some of these pages when he was in the House and as Vice President.

The group will total about 115 and parents will be coming in from all over the country for the commencement excercises. Apparently, this event has been either prior to or after the commencement excercises. The Separation of Powers doctrine would seem to dictate that the commencement would take place on Capitol Hill where they go to school in the mornings at the Library of Congress.

Dear Mr. President:

I am writing this letter to request a favor of you regarding your specifying that only parents and grandparents attend the graduation of the Capitol Pages at the White House. My son Jonathan, who is in charge of the Republican Pages working out of the Cloak Room, has three grandparents who will not be able to attend. Jonathan's younger brother Jim will be coming with me to Washington, D.C., especially for the graduation ceremonies (Jim is 15 years old) . Would it be possible for you to make an exception and allow him to accompany me to the White House Graduation Ceremony?

I don't feel that I could possibly attend without my son Jim coming, too. He is missing a week of school to make the trip, and I am missing two days of work (my parents are paying for my trip expenses).

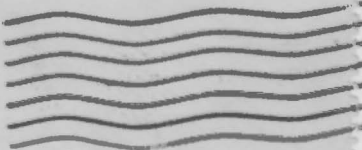
