SUBJECT: DOD Memorandum on MIA Issue

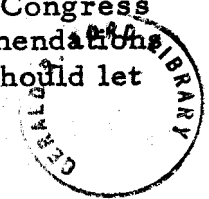
There are a number of problems in the approach proposed in the draft DOD memorandum on the MIA issue (Tab A), some of which are acknowledged in the memo:

-- An announcement that the Executive Branch was going to resolve MIA cases "in accordance with the law" (i. e., hold hearings and declare MIA's dead) would certainly arouse a storm of protest from many MIA families. The families would undoubtedly urge -- possibly with quick success -- rapid passage of presently proposed legislation to slow or halt any action by the Service Secretaries to declare MIA's dead.

-- MIA families would claim that the Executive Branch's decision on resolving MIA cases is further evidence that it wants to write off the MIA's. They would be strongly seconded by, among others, Congressman Rhodes, who will be a principal speaker at the Convention, and Senator Goldwater who also opposes an early resolution.

-- We will be in a stronger political position to resolve these cases after the Congress has reviewed the whole issue either in a Select Committee (proposed in Sonny Montgomery's bill) or an Armed Services Standing Committee (proposed by Madden and which I consider a preferable approach).

-- We should not, however, as the memorandum proposes, tell the Congress we are waiting to follow its lead and are putting the monkey on its back with 60/90 days deadline for recommendations. The Congress would resent this and probably could not come up with recommendations in this short a time. As far as Hill action is concerned, we should let nature take its course.

-- The Davis case (referred to on page 2 of the memorandum) is not sufficient justification for early resolutions. It is a sticky case, but we would do better to await the court's verdict. In any case, the relevant law does not seem to require early action or set any time limit on delaying resolution. If this is not so, there will eventually be court rulings to the contrary.

-- It may not be true that the Executive Branch has exhausted possibilities to resolve pending MIA cases; although we consider it unlikely that Communist authorities will cooperate with us on this issue.

-- The Defense Department is understandably anxious to resolve the status changes issue. However, the impact, so far as the President is concerned, would be wholly negative. We would be far better off to try to get Congress on record on this before putting the President on record on such an emotion-packed issue. The money involved is not that substantial any more and a little extra compassion, I think, is warranted.

In sum, I am opposed to the DOD draft memorandum.



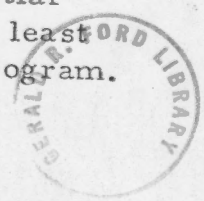

Bobbie spoke with Dick Wiley, General Counsel of DOD, this afternoon and it is Wiley's legal opinion that, if the conditions set forth below are met, DOD can legally provide transportation for MIA families to and from Washington, D. C. for meetings on July 22 through July 25, which include the 7th Annual Meeting of the National League of Families of American Prisoners and Missing In Southeast Asia, without violating the provisions of 31 U.S.C. § 551. The conditions are as follows:

- (1) DOD must present its own program on those dates which addresses DOD issues and operations.
- (2) Invitations to participate in this DOD program must be sent to all MIA families, including those families who are not members of the National League or who are not planning to attend the League meeting in D. C.
- (3) The DOD program must consist of at least two separate time block sections of at least two hours each and one of these sessions must be either on DOD premises or in a meeting room which DOD has specifically arranged to use for that purpose.
- (4) Substantive issues must be discussed at these sessions and must involve policy matters that DOD has full or partial policy responsibility for or a substantial interest in. At least half of these topics must not already be on the League program.



(5) DOD must make arrangements for any MIA family who so desires to read and discuss the full military file of the MIA with a qualified military caseworker from the appropriate service branch. The DOD invitation to all MIA families must state that the files are available and that these arrangements can be made.

The Counsel's Office agrees with the opinion of the General Counsel of DOD that the above conditions must be met in order to provide a proper legal basis for DOD to provide transportation to and from Washington, D. C. for MIA families on July 22-25. Responsibility for meeting these conditions must rest with the senior officials at DOD, and it is our recommendation that they be urged to give it their highest priority and personal attention.

Formation of a Presidential Task Force  
on the Missing in Action

I. BACKGROUND

The Republican Platform contains a plank calling for the establishment of a Presidential Task Force on the missing in action in Southeast Asia.

Accounting by the Vietnamese as well as the other Southeast Asia nations of those men who are still carried as missing in action and prisoners of war continues to be a matter of national concern. The National League of Families and the various veterans groups, who support your position on this, have been quite vocal concerning the need for an accounting.

In 1974/75 there seemed to be a growing agreement at the White House concerning the formation of a task force on MIA's. However, instead, the establishment of the House Select Committee on MIA's, headed by Congressman G. V. "Sonny" Montgomery (D-Miss), was thought to satisfy the need. That Committee had your support and that of the National League of Families. However, the League's support has eroded, particularly since "Sonny" Montgomery, in July, told the families that he expected the Committee's report to reflect a belief that there are no living American servicemen in Southeast Asia. The League also believes that the Committee accomplished nothing more than a cursory look into the problem.

There are currently approximately 800 men still listed as MIA's and POW's. Another 500 have been declared either killed in action or presumed to be dead. This has caused some concern for many of the families who believe that once the status of the individual has



been changed from MIA to killed in action or presumptive finding of death the need for an accounting will have been eliminated. Both the State and Defense Departments have assured the families that this isn't so and that regardless of the status of an individual, unless the remains have been returned, we will continue to seek an accounting.

The families have also pressed for an Executive Order which would stop all changes in status. However, they have been advised that the current moratorium at the Department of Defense, which requires that before a status review can be held on an MIA there must be a request from the immediate next of kin or unrefutable evidence must have surfaced, is satisfying that purpose. The families do not accept this rationale.

A Presidential Task Force, headed by someone of stature such as the Vice President and containing among its members respected individuals, could help assure those concerned during this period that the Administration is doing more than just the normal activity through State Department procedure.

Since the Republican Platform did call for the formation of a task force, and since such formation can only have positive results in terms of showing Administration interest in this sensitive matter, it would seem appropriate to now move ahead and announce the formation of such a body.

A preliminary "in house" meeting was held on September 9, 1976. The results of that meeting and a polling of our senior staff indicates that there is general agreement on the formation of the task force. General Scowcroft, however, believes that we should hold off at least until after the House Select Committee makes its report, which should be at the end of the year.

Should a task force be formed, it should be given specific responsibilities with a mandate to review what has been done up to now at State, Defense, and within the Select Committee. It should be required to determine what steps can and should be taken toward securing the desired accounting; a reporting date; and to satisfy any further mandate of the President on this matter.



II. OPTIONS

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Approval of the immediate establishment of a Presidential Task Force for the Missing in Action in Southeast Asia with general requirements outlined, and the selection of a chairman of stature.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Approval of the need for a Presidential Task Force for the Missing in Action in Southeast Asia, but a delay on implementation until the House Select Committee report is received and evaluated.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Disapproval of the need of a Presidential Task Force on the Missing in Action in Southeast Asia.

III. RECOMMENDATION

Decision at the earliest possible time. My preference is for Option 1.

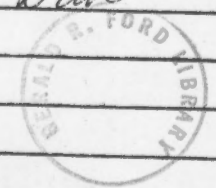

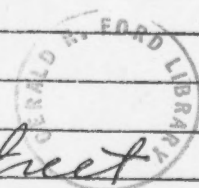
