TO: Rep. Al Quie (R-Minn)

RECOMMENDED BY: William E. Timmons *BT*

WHEN: Today, September 10

PURPOSE: To discuss two items of mutual interest.

BACKGROUND:

- A. Rep. Quie called Timmons today to request the President return the call today at his convenience. Al said that at the Pension bill signing the President asked him to telephone on September 10th.
- B. Quie says the President will know what this issue is about.
- C. Al also wants to briefly discuss the rumor that the President is considering a pardon for Watergate defendants. Quie believes there should be no pardon before sentencing and that the President should consider John Dean, Chuck Colson and others who are serving time now.

RECOMMENDATION

That the President return the call.
