SUBJECT: George Millias: Appointment with the President

I've arranged to meet George Millias, candidate to succeed Charles Gubser in the 10th C.D., shortly after arrival at the Century-Plaza on Thursday, October 31. I'll then find a few minutes of free time to introduce Millias to the President for photos and a very brief conversation, in the President's suite at the hotel.

The background is simply this: Gubser urgently requested a stop in San Jose on November 1 in behalf of Millias; the President apparently indicated a general willingness to comply; and, when I had to point out to Gubser that the schedule simply would not permit another stop, we settled for this personal meeting in Los Angeles.

In any case, it shouldn't take more than five minutes. Millias will bring a local (San Jose) reporter and his own photographer to assure coverage in the district.
