Pursuant to our conversation, I inquired of Secretary Butz whether or not Reed Dunn was affiliated with the cotton organization which Congressman Conte spoke against.

He is not.

The organization Conte referred to is Cotton Incorporated, run by someone named Dukes Wooters. Secretary Butz told me that Dunn's organization is in many ways a competitor of Cotton Incorporated and that Dunn is a rival of Wooters and not at all close to him.
