Food Committee

On September 9 you publically announced the formation of a Food Committee of the Economic Policy Board/National Security Council to monitor developments with respect to the sale of grains to the U.S.S.R.

The Committee would be responsible, under your direction, for:

- (1) Clearing negotiating instructions for a long-term grain sale to the Soviet Union.
- (2) Making recommendations regarding the amount of additional sales of grain to the Soviet Union during the 1975-76 crop year.
- (3) Considering the issue of shipping freight rates and any revision of the proportion of tonnage carried in U.S. vessels of grain shipments to the Soviet Union.
- (4) Developing and maintaining data on grain production and exports.

# Recommendations

That the Secretary of the Treasury and the Secretary of State serve as Co-Chairmen of the Food Committee with the Assistant to the President for Economic Affairs responsible for coordinating the staff work.
