Senator Laxalt called the President to tell him that Governor Reagan was in Mexico and would not be available until Sunday evening. He has, however, talked to Mr. Deaver, the Governor's aide. Mr. Deaver thinks that there should be a staff meeting of the various elements (PFC, RNC, Congressional Campaign Committees) next week to discuss the campaign and to see how Governor Reagan can fit in. Senator Laxalt agrees with this and suggests next Wednesday in his office at 1:30 or 2:00 p.m. Dave Russell will coordinate for the Senator. The Governor and Mrs. Reagan could then come to Washington to follow up on this meeting.
