2. WE HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT UPON ARRIVAL AT THE COMPOUND TRAIN STATION SECRETARY BREZHNEV WILL INVITE PRESIDENT FORD TO RIDE WITH HIM TO PRESIDENT FORD'S RESIDENCE. THE PRESIDENTIAL LIMOUSINE WILL BE STANDING BY.
3. ALL MEMBERS OF US PARTY SHOULD WEAR STAFF PINS AS THIS WILL BE ONE OF TWO FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION. ADVANCE TEAM WILL DISTRIBUTE SECOND FORM UPON ARRIVAL.
4. TIMES OF HEAD-TO-HEAD MEETINGS REMAIN TOTALLY UNOFFICIAL.
5. ADVANCE TEAM HAS BEEN ABLE TO ARRANGE WITH OUR HOSTS FOR A DUPLICATE DINNER SIMILAR TO THE "INFORMAL DINNER" FOR THOSE MEMBERS OF UNOFFICIAL PARTY NOT ATTENDING "INFORMAL DINNER" PLUS WORKING STAFF AND INCLUDING AFI CREW. THIS DINNER WILL OCCUR AT THE SAME TIME (8:00 PM) AND WILL BE IN THE DINING HALL AREA.

1. REQUEST FOLLOWING INFORMATION BE PRINTED AND DISTRIBUTED AT AN  
APPROPRIATE TIME - IN SEOUL AND/OR ON BOARD AIRCRAFT EN ROUTE  
TO VLADIVOSTOK.

2. WEATHER: VLADIVOSTOK HAS BEEN EXPERIENCING TEMPERATURES  
WELL BELOW FREEZING. THE WIND CHILL FACTOR AT THE AIRPORT  
FREQUENTLY CREATES THE EQUIVALENT OF BELOW-ZERO TEMPERATURES.  
ALL TRAVELERS TO VLADIVOSTOK SHOULD DRESS WARMLY, INCLUDING WARM  
HEADGEAR AND GLOVES. APPROXIMATELY A FOOT OF SNOW FELL THURSDAY,  
NOVEMBER 21, AND MORE SNOW IS POSSIBLE BEFORE THE ARRIVAL  
OF THE PARTY. OVERSHOES OR LIGHT BOOTS WOULD BE USEFUL DURING  
THE VISIT.

3. HOSPITALITY ITEMS: THE STAFF HOTEL HAS SPECIALTY SHOPS WHICH  
SELL SOUVENIRS FOR BOTH DOLLARS AND RUBLES. (THE LATTER CAN BE  
PURCHASED FOR DOLLARS). FAVORITE BRANDS OF TOILETRIES,  
CIGARETTES AND BEVERAGES MAY NOT, HOWEVER, BE AVAILABLE. MEMBERS  
OF THE PARTY MAY THEREFORE WISH TO PURCHASE SUFFICIENT QUANTITIES  
OF SUCH ITEMS BEFORE LEAVING SEOUL. (NOTE: INFORMATION IN PARA 2  
AND 3 WOULD BE PARTICULARLY USEFUL IF DISSEMINATED WELL BEFORE

CLASSIFIED MATERIAL: PERSONS REQUIRING CLASSIFIED MATERIAL ON BOARD THE TRAIN SHOULD HAND-CARRY THIS MATERIAL, FOR WHICH THEY WILL BE RESPONSIBLE, SINCE THERE WILL BE NO SECURE CLASSIFIED STORAGE ABOARD THE TRAIN. OTHER CLASSIFIED NEEDED DURING THE VISIT TO VLADIVOSTOK MAY BE DELIVERED TO MR. JOYCE, THE STATE SECRETARIAT CONTROL OFFICER, AT PLANESIDE, AND WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE STATE SECRETARIAT NSC OFFICE AREA IN THE WEST BASEMENT OF THE STAFF HOTEL UPON ARRIVAL. CLASSIFIED MATERIAL SHOULD BE RETURNED TO THIS AREA BEFORE 1300 HOURS NOVEMBER 24, FOR SECURE TRANSPORTATION TO PLANESIDE. SUCH MATERIAL MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED AS TO FLIGHT ON WHICH PASSENGER IS DEPARTING. CLASSIFIED MATERIAL NOT REQUIRED DURING THE VISIT TO VLADIVOSTOK SHOULD BE LEFT ABOARD THE RESPECTIVE AIRCRAFT.
