ALTERNATIVELY, TURN RIGHT ON 8TH ST AFTER EXITING FROM THE FREEWAY, LEFT ON M STREET AND INTO THE 9TH ST GATE. IF YOU ARE ENTERING THE NAVY YD BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 4:00 PM AND 5:30 PM, THE 8TH AND 9TH ST GATES ARE CLOSED. DURING THIS PERIOD, THE YARD MUST BE ENTERED THROUGH THE N STREET GATE, WHICH IS LOCATED AT THE JUNCTION OF 11TH AND N STREETS, S.E.

SEQUOIA IS BERTHED NEXT TO PIER ONE WITHIN THE NAVAL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT COMPOUND. SECURE PARKING IS AVAILABLE.
