AS WE CELEBRATE OUR BICENTENNIAL, WE THE PEOPLE OF  
THE UNITED STATES STILL ENJOY THE BLESSINGS OF LIBERTY AS WE  
SEEK A MORE PERFECT UNION FOR OURSELVES AND OUR POSTERITY.

OUR FIRST CENTURY SAW THE ESTABLISHMENT  
OF A FREE SYSTEM OF GOVERNMENT; THE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
STRONG AND FREE ECONOMIC SYSTEM MARKED OUR SECOND  
CENTURY.

OUR NATION'S FIRST CENTURY SAW THE FIRM ESTABLISHMENT  
OF A FREE SYSTEM OF GOVERNMENT ON THIS CONTINENT.

THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STRONG AND FREE ECONOMIC SYSTEM  
MARKED OUR SECOND CENTURY, TRANSFORMING AN UNDERDEVELOPED  
COUNTRY INTO THE MIGHTIEST AND MOST PRODUCTIVE NATION IN  
HUMAN HISTORY.



THE GREAT CHALLENGE OF OUR THIRD CENTURY IS THE  
ADVANCEMENT OF EACH CITIZEN'S PERSONAL FREEDOM TO FULFILL  
HIS OR HER POTENTIAL IN LIFE, LIBERTY AND THE PURSUIT OF  
HAPPINESS.

THIS IS THE GREAT GOAL WHICH I COMMEND TO MY  
COUNTRYMEN FOR THE THIRD CENTURY OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE.
