11:45 a. m. You will be escorted to the Family Quarters. As your guests leave the White House, they will receive a silver Betty Ford pen.

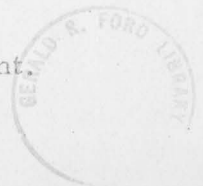
White House tour guides will be available for those who are interested in a tour of the White House.

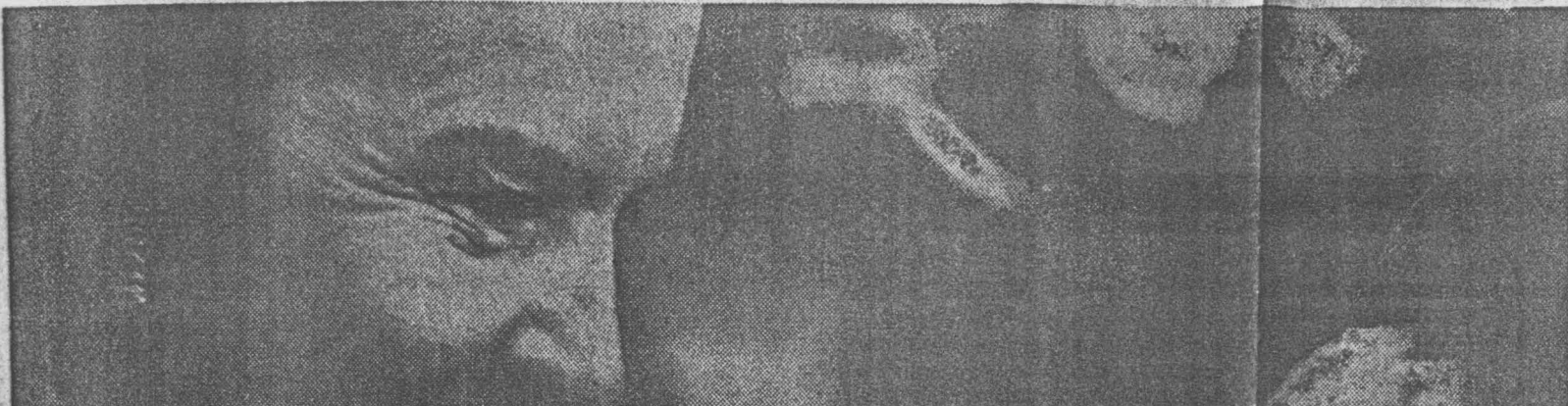
