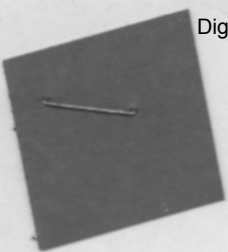


Dear Miss Ford:

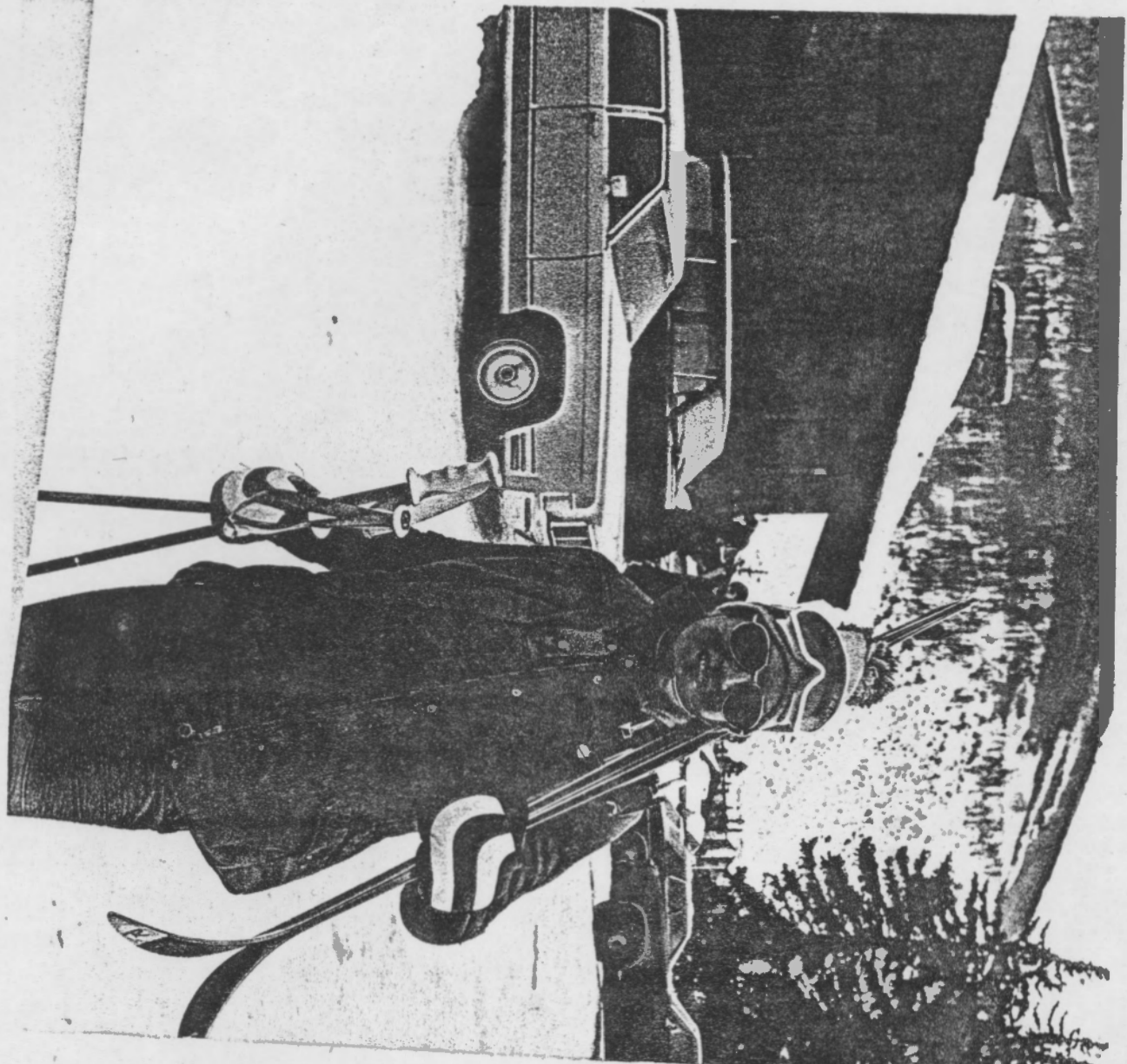
