
Sir:

I have the honor to submit for your consideration an amendment to the request for appropriations transmitted in the budget for the fiscal year 1975, providing funding in the amount of \$1,900,000 for the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.

purpose for fiscal year 1973:  
Provided further, That the requirements of section 307(e) of Public Law 89-10, as amended, shall be satisfied when the combined fiscal effort of the local education agency and the State for the preceding fiscal year was not less than such combined fiscal effort in the second preceding fiscal year/ \$159,600,000 of which \$7,000,000 shall be for educational broadcasting facilities and shall remain available until expended. (Department of Health, Education, and Welfare Act, 1974; additional authorizing legislation to be proposed for \$105,000,000.)

The proposed amendment would provide for programs under the Environmental Education Act Amendments of 1974. The funds requested would be used to help expand the capability of the educational system to provide environmental education programs both inside and outside the classroom.
