(Biographical Data)

Paul W. McCracken is currently an Edmund Ezra Day University Professor at the University of Michigan. He was previously Chairman of the Council of Economic Advisers from 1969 to 1971.

From 1956 to 1959, he was a member of the Council of Economic Advisers during the Eisenhower Administration and is a former financial economist and director of research at the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis.

Dr. McCracken was born on December 29, 1915 in Richland, Iowa. He received his B.A. from William Penn College in 1937 and received his M.A. and his Ph.D. from Harvard University in 1942 and 1948. He joined the faculty at the University of Michigan in 1948 as an associate professor of economics and was appointed a full professor in 1950 and was named Edmund Ezra Day University Professor of Business Administration in 1966.

He is married to the former Emily Ruth Siler and they have two children. They reside in Ann Arbor, Michigan.
