Nessen *********** still had nothing to say about reports of a delay in Ford's appearance before Hungate's subcommittee until the Watergate jury is sequestered. "I can't say anything about Hungate," said Ne ssen.

Ne ssen said a new pool procedure is in effect that will permit closer coverage of Ford on the way to and from events, and at Ford's public appearances. The pool will be issued a se parate identification card that will will permit them to stay with Ford until he enters holding rooms, private receptions, and windwarm other places whe re no coverage will be permitted.

Nexemaximize Nessen made several pleas for cooperation with the new system, specifically asking that mexems reporters must maximalize and photographers not in the pool rely on the pool and don't try to crowd in.
