The President today announced his intention to nominate Stanley S. Brotman, of Vineland, New Jersey, to be a United States District Judge for the District of New Jersey. He will succeed Mitchell H. Cohen who retired effective August 31, 1974.

Mr. Brotman has been engaged in the practice of law in Vineland, New Jersey since 1952. He has been with the firm of Shapiro, Brotman, Eisenstat and Capizola since 1957.

Mr. Brotman was born on July 27, 1924, in Vineland, New Jersey. He received his B. A. degree from Yale College in 1947. He graduated from Harvard Law School in 1950. He was admitted to the New Jersey State Bar in 1950.

He served in the United States Army from 1943 to 1945 and from 1951 to 1952 as a First Lieutenant.

Mr. Brotman is married to the former Suzanne Simon and they have two children. They reside in Vineland, New Jersey.
