NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed S. 58 - Compensation and other emoluments attached to the Office of the Attorney General, which restores the Attorney General's salary to \$60,000. The salary level was lowered to \$35,000 on December 10, 1973 to permit William Saxbe to serve as Attorney General and still meet Constitutional requirements that he not be appointed to a position in which the salary had been increased by Congress during his term of office.
