The President today announced his intention to nominate John Dellenback, of Medford, Oregon, to be Associate Director of ACTION (International Operations). He will succeed Nicholas Craw who resigned effective September 1, 1974.

Mr. Dellenback was elected in 1966 to the United States House of Representatives and served in the 90th Congress. He was reelected and served successively in the 91st, 92nd and 93rd Congresses. He was a member of the Oregon State Legislature from 1960 to 1966, prior to his election to Congress. He was engaged in the private practice of law from 1950 to 1960.

Mr. Dellenback was born on November 6, 1918, in Chicago, Illinois, and received his B.S. degree from Yale University in 1940. He was a member of Phi Beta Kappa. He received his J.D. degree from the University of Michigan in 1949. He also did additional graduate work at Northwestern University during the summers of 1946 and 1949.

Mr. Dellenback is married to the former Mary Jane Benedict and they have three children. They reside in Washington, D.C.
