Sir:

I have the honor to submit for your consideration a proposed appropriation language change for fiscal year 1975 which would increase a limitation not affecting budget authority. The details are as follows:

EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT


Special Assistance to the President

Of the amount provided under this head in the "Treasury, Postal Service, and General Government Appropriation Act, 1975", \$40,000 shall be available for expenses of travel, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 501 of the Act.

This proposal will provide for necessary travel for the executive staff of the Vice President by increasing the limitation from \$30,000 to \$40,000. No additional funds are required since the expenditures for travel will be made within the existing appropriation for "Special Assistance to the President".

I have carefully reviewed this proposed appropriation language and am satisfied that it is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that this proposal be transmitted to the Congress.
