Breakfast Meeting With British Prime Minister Harold Wilson

The Residence

The pool was taken in at 8:35 a.m. for the breakfast meeting. Representing the U.S. were the President, Secretary Kissinger, Brent Scowcroft and Helmut Sonnenfeldt. Representing Great Britain were Prime Minister Wilson, Foreign Secretary Callaghan and Sir John Hunt.

The conversation was light. Pipe smoking habits were discussed. Wilson mentioned that he put his pipes in his pockets and the President commented that you burn your pockets that way.

Kissinger was needling Callaghan about Leeds' loss in the European soccer finals. Wilson said that he was going directly back to Checkers and he mentioned that it was spring break time in Parliament. While the photographers were taking pictures, the President asked if everybody was bright and cheery.

The President and the Prime Minister walked out of the residence at 9:30 a.m. stopping for pictures. Both delegations then left for NATO headquarters.
