The President today announced his intention to nominate Jesse W. Grider, of Louisville, Kentucky, to be United States Marshal for the Western District of Kentucky for a term of four years. He will succeed William B. Henderson whose term expired April 22, 1974.

Since 1973, Mr. Grider has been Chief Deputy United States Marshal for the Western District of Kentucky.
