NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has designated Gerald L. Parsky, Assistant Secretary of the Treasury to be Executive Secretary of the East-West Trade Board. This is a new position created by Executive Order 11846 of March 27, 1975.

Mr. Parsky was appointed Assistant Secretary of Treasury on June 20, 1974.

The East-West Foreign Trade Board is to monitor trade between persons and agencies of the United States Government and nonmarket economy countries or instrumentalities of such countries to insure that such trade will be in the national interest of the United States.
