NOMINATIONS SENT TO THE SENATE ON JULY 7, 1975:

Herbert J. Spiro, of Pennsylvania, to be Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United States of America to the United Republic of Cameroon, and to serve concurrently and without additional compensation as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United States of America to the Republic of Equatorial Guinea.

Julia P. Cooper, of the District of Columbia, to be an Associate Judge of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals for the term of fifteen years, vice Hubert G. Pair, resigned.

Bruce S. Mencher, of the District of Columbia, to be an Associate Judge of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia for the term of fifteen years, vice Edward A. Beard, term expired.
