NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President's Schedule

The President came to the Oval Office at 7:45 a.m. today for his usual morning staff meetings.

At 9:20 a.m., the President greeted State Presidents and National Officers of the Future Farmers of America who are in Washington for the State President's Conference. The FFA presented the President with a stand holding 10 original flags flown in the U.S. and the FFA flag. (The 10 flags are: Saint George Cross, Grand Union, Red Ensign, Continental Flag, Pine-Tree Flag, Gadsden Flag, Cambridge Flag, Betsy Ross Flag, National Flag of May 1795, National Flag of July 4, 1960). Last October the President addressed the FFA annual convention in Kansas City. (OPEN COVERAGE)

At 2:00 this afternoon the President will meet with his economic and energy advisors for a general review of the economic situation and a discussion of capital formation.

At 3:00 p.m. today the President will meet with Congressman Dan Rostenkowski who will report on his mission as the President's Special Representative to the Poznan International Trade Fair in Poland.

At 5:30 this afternoon the President will meet with representatives of the National League of Families of American Prisoners and Missing in Southeast Asia, and representatives of Voices in Vital America for a discussion of U.S. efforts for the fullest possible accounting for men missing in Southeast Asia.
