The Agreement on Trade Relations between the United States of America and the Socialist Republic of Romania, with annexes, was signed at Bucharest on April 2, 1975; and

The Congress of the United States of America by its concurrent resolution of July 28, 1975, in accordance with the Trade Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-618, January 3, 1975; 88 Stat. 1978), approved the Agreement, with annexes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Gerald R. Ford, President of the United States of America, accept and confirm the Agreement, with annexes.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have signed this acceptance.

DONE this third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-five and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundredth.

PROTOCOL

The undersigned,

Henry A. Kissinger, Secretary of State of the United States of America, and

George Macovescu, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Socialist Republic of Romania,

being duly authorized by their respective governments, have met for the purpose of exchanging the instruments by which is accepted, in accordance with the legal procedures in force in each of the two states, the Agreement on Trade Relations between the United States of America and the Socialist Republic of Romania, with annexes, signed at Bucharest on April 2, 1975.

The respective instruments having been compared and found to be in due form, the exchange took place this day.

In witness whereof, the respective plenipotentiaries have signed the present protocol.

Done in duplicate, in the English and Romanian languages, at Sinaia this third day of August, 1975.
