The President's Schedule

The President came to the Oval Office at 7:40 a.m. today and met with members of his staff during the morning.

At 10:30 a.m., the President is scheduled to meet with Commerce Secretary Rogers C. B. Morton, FEA Administrator Frank Zarb, Council of Economic Advisers Chairman Alan Greenspan and members of the White House staff. The purpose of the meeting is for the President to receive an energy update.

At 11:00 a.m., the President will hold an Economic/Energy meeting in the Cabinet Room. This is one of the periodic meetings held with members of his staff.

At noon, the President will meet with Senator Mike Mansfield in the Oval Office. The meeting was requested by Senator Mansfield to discuss the President's action on S. 1849.

At 3:45 p.m., the President will meet with Maine Representatives William Cohen and David Emery and Mayor Burton Braley of Saco, Maine, and Mayor Lucien Dutrembley of Biddedorf, Maine. The meeting was requested by the Maine Congressmen to discuss matters affecting their state.
