NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today resubmitted the nomination of Isabel A. Burgess, of Phoenix, Arizona, to be a member of the National Transportation Safety Board for a term expiring December 31, 1979. She was appointed to the Board on October 7, 1969, for a term which expired on December 31, 1974.

Mrs. Burgess was a member of the Arizona State House of Representatives for ten years. She was elected to the Arizona State Senate in 1966 until her appointment to the National Transportation Safety Board in 1969.

The President today resubmitted the nomination of Earl J. Silbert of the District of Columbia to be United States Attorney for the District of Columbia for a term of four years.

Since January, 1974, he has been the court appointed United States Attorney for the District of Columbia.
