# The President's Schedule

The President arrived at the Oval Office at 7:40 a.m. today and held meetings with members of his staff until 9:00 a.m.

He greeted leaders of the U. S. Jaycees in the Rose Garden at 9:00 a.m. The group included State Presidents and Executive Committee Chairmen, a total of 88 Jaycees who toured the White House prior to meeting with the President. The new national Jaycee President is Dick Robinson of Lake Orion, Michigan.

The Bresident continues meetings with his staff until 11:30 a.m., then he will hold a meeting with four Cabinet members and four university presidents. The subject will be the federal role in insuring there is no discrimination in employment in federally-funded colleges and universities. Attending will be Secretaries Coleman, Dunlop, Mathews, and Attorney General Levi, along with Dr. Kenneth J. Arrow of Harvard, Dr. Cynthia Epstein of Queens College, City University of New York, Dr. Paul Seabury, University of California (Berkeley), and Dr. Thomas Sowell, University of California (Los Angeles).

At 3:00 p.m., the President will meet with Secretary General Joseph M. A., H. Luns of NATO in the Oval Office.
