NOTICE TO THE PRESS

CALIFORNIA TRIP

The President will make a trip to Oklahoma and California on Friday, September 19 and will return to Washington on Monday, September 22. (All times are local.)

Friday, September 19

The President will depart the White House at about 1:30 p.m. Attend the Oklahoma State Fair at about 4 p.m. He will attend an Oklahoma State Republican Fund Raiser at about 6 p.m. He will depart Oklahoma City and arrive in Los Angeles at about 8 p.m. The President (and the press) will overnight in Los Angeles.

Saturday, September 20

At 10:30 a.m., the President will dedicate Firestone Fieldhouse at Pepperdine University in Malibu. During the afternoon, he will play golf at Pebble Beach. He will overnight in Monterey. (Press will overnight in San Francisco. The Air Force One pool will remain with the President and cover his Pebble Beach and Monterey activities.)

Sunday, September 21

In the morning, he will play golf at Pebble Beach. At 4 p.m., he will dedicate new facilities at Stanford University (Palo Alto) School of Law. At 5 p.m., he will leave there to go to Anaheim, where he will address a dinner of the National Association of Life Underwriters Convention at Disneyland. He will go back to Monterey overnight. (The Air Force One Pool will cover the morning activities at Pebble Beach. The remainder of the press will fly to Stanford for the activities there and then return to San Francisco for the night. The Pool will go with the President to Monterey.)

Monday, September 22

At about 10 a.m., the President will leave Monterey for San Francisco, where he will address the Building and Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO convention at about 11:00 a.m. At 12:15 p.m. he will address the World Affairs Council of Northern California in San Francisco. He will depart San Francisco at about 2:30 p.m. and arrive back at the White House at about 10:30 p.m.
