NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has received the April 17, 1975, Report of the Board of Visitors to the United States Air Force Academy. The Board, which met at Colorado Springs, Colorado, is required by law to meet annually to inquire into the state of morale and discipline, the curriculum, instruction, physical equipment, financial affairs, academic methods and other matters relating to the Academy which the Board decides to consider and to report its findings to the President.

The Board consists of 15 members: six Presidential appointees, three Vice Presidential appointees, and four appointed by the Speaker of the House. The remaining two members are designated, respectively, by the Chairmen of the House and Senate Armed Services Committees.
