I am transmitting, herewith, in quadruplicate, three Supplemental Estimates of Appropriations for the Fiscal Year 1976, totaling \$1,034,000, and one Supplemental Estimate of Appropriation for the Transition Quarter, in the amount of \$29,000, for the Legislative Branch, Architect of the Capitol, as follows:

For an additional amount for "Capitol Grounds", for modifications to and replacement of existing traffic signals and installation of additional traffic signals and all items appurtenant thereto, conforming to previous authorization for such purpose contained in the Legislative Branch Appropriation Act, 1974 (87 Stat. 541), \$100,000.

SENATE OFFICE BUILDINGS

For an additional amount for "Senate Office Buildings", \$721,000, of which \$200,000 shall remain available until expended.


For an additional amount for "Senate Office Buildings" for the period July 1, 1976, through September 30, 1976, \$29,000.

LIBRARY BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS
STRUCTURAL AND MECHANICAL CARE

For an additional amount for "Library Buildings and Grounds,
Structural and Mechanical Care", \$213,000.
