

Social and Economic Statistics Administration


Periodic Censuses and Programs

For an additional amount for "Periodic censuses and programs", \$4,940,000, to remain available until expended.

This proposed supplemental will provide for the processing of place of residence information which will be obtained from 1975 Federal Income Tax Forms. This information is to be used in the distribution formula for allocating revenue sharing and other Federal program funds.

I have carefully reviewed the proposal for appropriations contained in this document and am satisfied that this request is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that this proposal be transmitted to the Congress.
