The President today announced the appointment of R. Randall Vosbeck, of Alexandria, Virginia, as a member of the National Capital Planning Commission for a term expiring January 1, 1977. This is a new position created by Public Law 93-198 of December 24, 1973.

Mr. Vosbeck is an architect and a partner in the firm of Vosbeck, Vosbeck, Kendrick Redinger in Alexandria, Virginia.

The Commission consists of twelve members, three whom are appointed by the President. The purpose of the Commission is to prepare and adopt a comprehensive, consistent, and coordinated plan for the National Capital. The Commission was established as the central planning agency for the Federal Government in the National Capital for the purpose of preserving the important natural and historical features.
