The President today announced the appointment of two persons as members of the National Highway Safety Advisory Committee. They are:

Edward McBroom, of Kankakee, Illinois, President, Jeffers, McBroom and Frerichs (car dealership), Kankakee, Illinois. He succeeds E. A. Cafiero, who resigned effective August 12, 1975. This is for the remainder of a term expiring March 15, 1976.

John Cyril Malloy, of Miami, Florida, private practice of law, Miami, Florida. He will succeed Mrs. James Emrick whose term has expired. This is for a term expiring March 15, 1978.

The Committee consists of 35 members serving terms of three years and was established by Public Law 89-564 of September 9, 1966 to provide advice and counsel to the Secretary of Transportation on Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards and other highway safety matters.
