The President today announced his intention to nominate Paul K. Wormeli, of San Jose, California, to be Deputy Administrator for Administration of the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration. He will succeed Charles R. Work who resigned effective November 21, 1975. Mr. Wormeli has been Vice President of Public Systems, Incorporated in Sunnyvale, California since 1969.

Mr. Wormeli was born on August 1, 1938, in Chicago, Illinois. He received his B.S.E.E. degree from the University of New Mexico in 1959. He attended George Washington University and received his M.E.A. in 1964. From 1959 to 1965 he served as a Lieutenant in the United States Navy.

In 1965, Mr. Wormeli became Law Enforcement Program Manager of Sylvania Electronics Systems, and served in that position until he joined Public Systems, Incorporated in 1969.

Mr. Wormeli is married to the former Nancy Ann Terwilliger and they have two children.
