The President and Mrs. Ford Thursday will attend a birthday reception honoring Representative Al Cederberg of Michigan and a separate reception held by the National Federation of Business and Professional Women's Clubs. He will leave the White House at 6:30 p.m. and return at about 7:30 p.m.

Representative Cederberg's reception will be held from 6 to 8 p.m. in the Crystal Room of the Sheraton Carlton Hotel. Sponsors of the event are Senators Hugh Scott, Bob Griffin and Milton Young and Representatives John Rhodes, and Bob Michel, and Secretary Simon. Representative Cederberg's birthday is Saturday, March 6, and he will be 58 years old. About 250 persons are expected to attend.

Following that the President and Mrs. Ford will go to the Sheraton Park Hotel to greet members of the National Federation of Business and Professional Women's Clubs Legislative Conference.

BPW has a biannual legislative conference in Washington for its state leader-ship and members to encourage women to become involved in all phases of legislative and political action techniques. The National Federation is composed of 160,000 members. About 1,000 members will be present.
