The President today announced the establishment of a Federal Executive Board in Houston, Texas. This new Board will bring the total of Federal Executive Boards now existing in selected metropolitan centers to twenty-six.

As in the existing Federal Executive Board cities, the new Board will endeavor to achieve economy and efficiency in operations through interagency cooperation, and to promote close working relationships not only among Federal activities but with local governments as well.

The Federal Executive Boards are currently located in Albuquerque-Santa Fe, Atlanta, Baltimore, Boston, Buffalo, Chicago, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Dallas-Ft. Worth, Denver, Detroit, Honolulu-Pacific, Kansas City, Los Angeles, Miami, Newark, New Orleans, New York, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Portland, St. Louis, San Francisco, Seattle, and Twin Cities.
