NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of John C. Peterson, of Topeka, Kansas, as United States Representative on the Kansas-Nebraska Big Blue River Compact Administration. This is a new position created by Public Law 92-308 of June 2, 1972. Mr. Peterson is an attorney in the private practice of law.

Public Law 92-308 grants the consent of the Congress to the States of Kansas and Nebraska to negotiate and enter into a compact to promote interstate comity between the States of Nebraska and Kansas; to achieve an equitable apportionment of the water of the Big Blue River Basin between the two States and to promote orderly development thereof; and to encourage continuation of the active pollution-abatement programs in each of the two States and to seek further reduction in both natural and man-made pollution of the Big Blue River Basin.
