The President will visit Indiana and Georgia on April 22 and 23. Listed below is a very tentative schedule of the activities for those days. Additional events and items will be added next week.

The President will speak at Butler University in Indianapolis at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 22. He will remain overnight in Indianapolis.

On Friday, the 23rd, the President, mid-morning, will travel to Evansville, where he has accepted the invitation of Mayor Russell G. Lloyd to appear before a forum for a question and answer session.

At noon, the President will have a public motorcade through the downtown Evansville area and will depart for Atlanta in the afternoon.

At 4 p.m., the President will address the Military Order of the World Wars' Annual Service at the Peachtree Presbyterian Church.

Other activities for both Indiana and Georgia will be announced next week.
