NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed the following bills:

- S. 719 - Renewal of the Sons of the American Legion Patent.
- S. 720 - Renewal of the American Legion Patent.
- S. 721 - Renewal of the American Legion Auxiliary Patent.

The three bills renew and extend the design patents for the emblems and insignia on the badges of the three organizations for 14 years from the date of approval of the bills. The patent authority would have ended on June 25, 1976, without the extension.

The President has also signed:

- S. 804 - Relief of Zoraida E. Lastimosa. The bill enables Miss Lastimosa to qualify for first-preference immigration status as the unmarried daughter of a U.S. citizen.
- S. 832 - Relief of Kristen Marisol Kneebone. The bill permits issuance of an immigrant visa to Kristen as an adopted alien daughter of a U.S. citizen.
- S. 2308 - Bristol Cliffs Wilderness Area, Vermont. The bill modifies the boundaries of the Bristol Cliffs Wilderness Area, Vermont, by eliminating all private and certain National Forest lands.
- S. 3108 - Energy Research and Development Administration Authorization. The bill authorizes supplemental appropriations of \$34 million to ERDA for Fiscal Year 1976, and \$23 million for the transition quarter.
